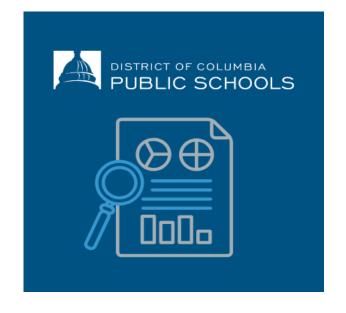

Year-To-Year Budget Notes

Brightwood's initial formula allocation is \$12,127,033. This is an increase of \$539,706 compared to last year. School budgets are primarily driven by two key factors: enrollment and unique student need. In SY20-21, Brightwood Education Campus will only serve PK3-5th grade and 8th grade, as their 7th grade moves to the newly opened Ida B. Wells Middle School. In SY19-20, Brightwood's projected enrollment was 675. For SY20-21, their projected enrollment is 663, a decrease of 12 students. However, due to an increase in the number of students receiving special education services with more intensive needs, Brightwood requires one additional self-contained special education classroom, resulting in an increased allocation of staff members and overall special education allocation. Additionally, due to an increase in the number of English Language Learners (ELL), Brightwood is receiving an increased ELL allocation.
