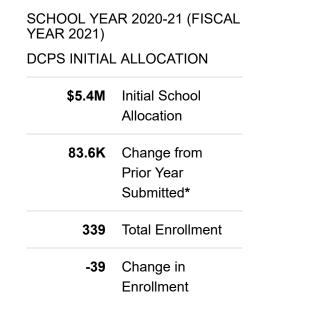

Year-To-Year Budget Notes

Capitol Hill Montessori's initial formula allocation is \$5,358,772. This is an increase of \$83,627 compared to last year. School budgets are primarily driven by two key factors: enrollment and unique student need. In SY19-20, Capitol Hill Montessori's projected enrollment was 378. For SY20-21, their projected enrollment is 339, a decrease of 39 students. At the same time, due to an increase in the number of students receiving special education services with less intensive needs, Capitol Hill Montessori requires an increase in the number of special education staff members, resulting in an increased special education allocation.
