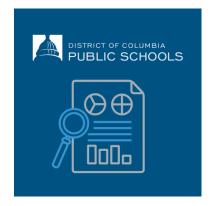

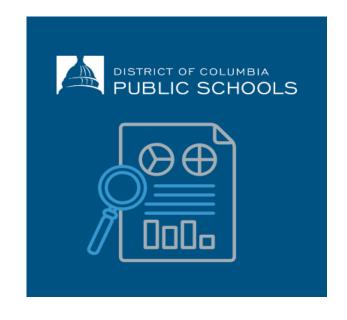

Enrollment
