

Year-To-Year Budget Notes

Roosevelt's initial formula allocation is \$13,953,440. This is an increase of \$1,611,143 compared to last year. School budgets are primarily driven by two key factors: enrollment and unique student need. In SY19-20, Roosevelt's projected enrollment was 681. For SY20-21, their projected enrollment is 820, an increase of 139 students. At the same time, due to a decrease in the number of students receiving special education services with more intensive needs, 1 self-contained special education classroom at Roosevelt HS is no longer required, resulting in a decreased allocation of staff members and special education allocation compared to last year. However, due to an increase in the number of English Language Learners (ELL), Roosevelt is receiving an increased ELL allocation.
