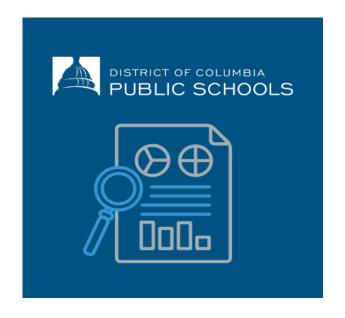

Enrollment

Ross' initial formula allocation is \$3,050,067. This is an increase of \$131,104 compared to last year. School budgets are primarily driven by two key factors: enrollment and unique student need. In SY19-20, Ross' projected enrollment was 181. For SY20-21, their projected enrollment is 184, an increase of 3 students. Additionally, due to an increase in the number of students receiving special education services with less intensive needs, Ross requires an increase in the number of special education staff members, resulting in an increased special education allocation.
