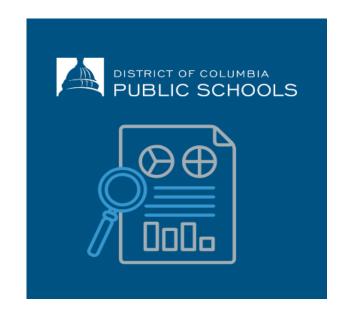

Year-To-Year Budget Notes

Stevens Early Learning Center's initial formula allocation is \$2,549,496. School budgets are primarily driven by two key factors: enrollment and unique student need. In SY20-21, Stevens Early Learning Center will open its doors for the first time to welcome students in SY20-21. The building will include both a DCPS early childhood (PK3-PK4) program and zero-to-three program operated by a community-based organization. In SY20-21 Stevens Early Learning Center will open 8 DCPS Pre-Kindergarten (PK) classrooms (3 PK3, 2 PK4, 2 non-categorical, 1 autism). This is an addition of 107 PK seats, of which nearly 80 will be offered in the 2020-2021 My School DC lottery.
