Hart's initial formula allocation was \$7,034,600. To support the school's ongoing improvement efforts, Hart received \$50,000 in Chancellor's Initial Budget Assistance. This brought the initial allocation to \$7,084,600. After initial allocations were released, Hart requested additional budget assistance funds and received \$110,891. Therefore, Hart's submitted budget total is \$7,195,461. This is an increase of \$789,649 compared to last year. School budgets are primarily driven by two key factors: enrollment and unique student need. In SY19-20, Hart's projected enrollment was 353. For SY20-21, their projected enrollment is 453, an increase of 100 students. Hart is not projecting significant changes to the number of students receiving special education or English Language Learner (ELL) services compared to last year. As a Connected School, Hart is also expected to benefit from approximately \$135,000, not included in the initial allocation or submitted budget totals.
