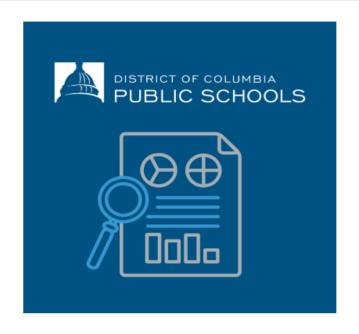

## Year-To-Year Budget Notes

**Enrollment** 

Bunker Hill Elementary School's initial formula allocation is \$4,292,511. This is a decrease of \$22,313 compared to last year. School budgets are primarily driven by two factors: enrollment and unique student need. In SY2020-21, Bunker Hill's projected enrollment was 247. In SY2021-22, the school's projected enrollment is 231, a decrease of 16 students. As a result, the school is receiving one fewer general education teacher. Due to a decrease in projected English Learner (EL) enrollment, the school is receiving one fewer EL staff allocation. Based upon DCPS' school mental health allocation model, which considers individual student service needs (e.g., special education and 504 service hours), as well as specialized programming, the school is receiving 0.5 additional psychologists.

NEW: Bunker Hill will also receive additional stimulus funding in the approximate amount of \$124,450 to provide supplemental services to accelerate learning recovery and support students' social-emotional development. These funds are not included in the initial formula allocation total.

Levels of Flexibility Key
