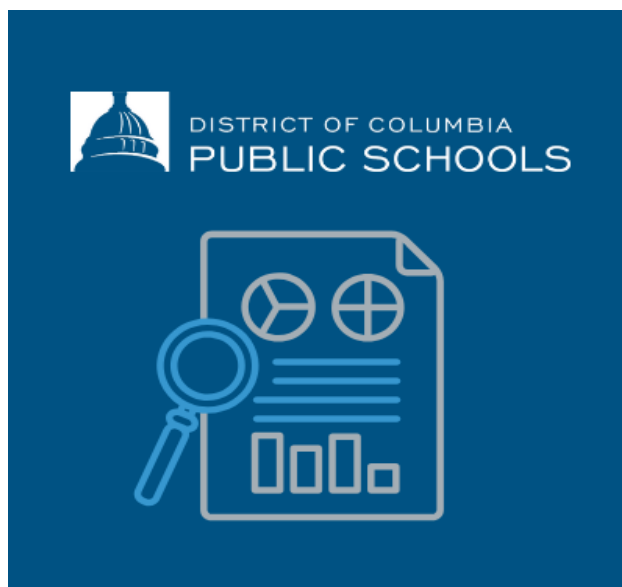

Year-To-Year Budget Notes

Hendley Elementary School's initial formula allocation is \$5,314,083. This is a decrease of \$220,823 compared to last year. School budgets are primarily driven by two factors: enrollment and unique student need. In SY2020-21, Hendley's projected enrollment was 341. In SY2021-22, the school's projected enrollment is 310, a decrease of 31 students. As a result, the school is receiving two fewer general education teachers. Based upon DCPS' school mental health allocation model, which considers individual student service needs (e.g., special education and 504 service hours), as well as specialized programming, the school is receiving one fewer social worker. Hendley is receiving \$690,843 in stabilization. In SY2020-21, Hendley received \$475,000 in one-time Chancellor's Initial Budget Assistance, which is not part of the school's initial SY2021-22 budget. To support the school's ongoing improvement efforts, Hendley is receiving \$225,138 in Chancellor's Initial Budget Assistance. This brings the total SY2021-22 initial allocation to \$5,539,221.

NEW: Hendley will also receive additional stimulus funding in the approximate amount of \$302,483 to provide supplemental services to accelerate learning recovery and support students' social-emotional development. These funds are not included in the initial formula allocation total.
