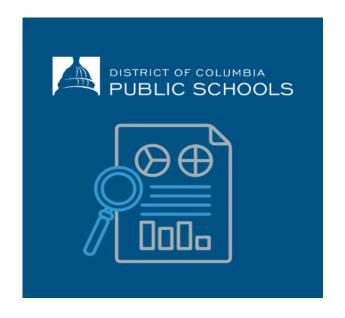

Year-To-Year Budget Notes

Murch Elementary School's initial formula allocation is \$7,329,384. This is an increase of \$79,631 compared to last year. School budgets are primarily driven by two factors: enrollment and unique student need. In SY2020-21, Murch's projected enrollment was 651. In SY2021-22, the school's projected enrollment is 614, a decrease of 37 students. Rising position costs contribute to the increased overall allocation in SY2021-22. Based upon DCPS' school mental health allocation model, which considers individual student service needs (e.g., special education and 504 service hours), as well as specialized programming, the school is receiving 0.5 additional psychologists and one fewer social worker.

NEW: Murch will also receive additional stimulus funding in the approximate amount of \$93,296 to provide supplemental services to accelerate learning recovery and support students' social-emotional development. These funds are not included in the initial formula allocation total.
