

Year-To-Year Budget Notes

Nalle Elementary School's initial formula allocation is \$5,142,692. This is a decrease of \$93,215 compared to last year. School budgets are primarily driven by two factors: enrollment and unique student need. In SY2020-21, Nalle's projected enrollment was 344. In SY2021-22, the school's projected enrollment is 326, a decrease of 18 students. The SY2021-22 budget does not include designated funding for Extended Day. Schools may choose to use their flexible funds (e.g., administrative premium) or stimulus funds to support learning outside of traditional school hours.

NEW: Nalle will also receive additional stimulus funding in the approximate amount of \$275,313 to provide supplemental services to accelerate learning recovery and support students' social-emotional development. These funds are not included in the initial formula allocation total.
