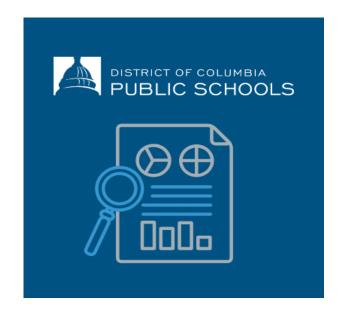

Year-To-Year Budget Notes

Enrollment

Peabody Elementary School's initial formula allocation is \$3,258,053. This is an increase of \$265,154 compared to last year. School budgets are primarily driven by two factors: enrollment and unique student need. In SY2020-21, Peabody's projected enrollment was 221. In SY2021-22, the school's projected enrollment is 219, a decrease of 2 students. Based upon DCPS' school mental health allocation model, which considers individual student service needs (e.g., special education and 504 service hours), as well as specialized programming, the school is receiving 0.5 additional psychologists and one additional social worker.

NEW: Peabody will also receive additional stimulus funding in the approximate amount of \$50,000 to provide supplemental services to accelerate learning recovery and support students' social-emotional development. These funds are not included in the initial formula allocation total.

Levels of Flexibility Key
