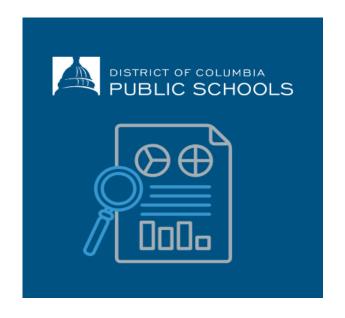

## Year-To-Year Budget Notes

Tubman Elementary School's initial formula allocation is \$9,190,542. This is a decrease of \$335,835 compared to last year. School budgets are primarily driven by two factors: enrollment and unique student need. In SY2020-21, Tubman's projected enrollment was 593. In SY2021-22, the school's projected enrollment is 549, a decrease of 44 students. Due to changes in self-contained programming allocations for Early Learning Support classrooms, Tubman will have one fewer self-contained special education classroom teacher, resulting in a decreased allocation of staff members. Due to a decrease in projected English Learner (EL) enrollment, the school requires one fewer EL staff allocation. Based upon DCPS' school mental health allocation model, which considers individual student service needs (e.g., special education and 504 service hours), as well as specialized programming, the school is receiving 0.5 fewer psychologists and one fewer social worker. To support the school's ongoing improvement efforts, Tubman is receiving \$112,569 in Chancellor's Initial Budget Assistance. This brings the total SY2021-22 initial allocation to \$9,303,111.

NEW: Tubman will also receive additional stimulus funding in the approximate amount of \$344,509 to provide supplemental services to accelerate learning recovery and support students' social-emotional development. These funds are not included in the initial formula allocation total.
