

Year-To-Year Budget Notes

West Elementary School's initial formula allocation is \$5,898,340. This is an increase of \$245,813 compared to last year. School budgets are primarily driven by two factors: enrollment and unique student need. In SY2020-21, West's projected enrollment was 355. In SY2021-22, the school's projected enrollment is 366, an increase of 11 students. West requires an additional general education teacher due to limits on average classroom size. Due to changes in self-contained programming, West will house two additional self-contained special education classrooms, resulting in an increased allocation of staff members. Due to a decrease in projected English Learner (EL) enrollment, the school requires two fewer EL staff allocations. Based upon DCPS' school mental health allocation model, which considers individual student service needs (e.g., special education and 504 service hours), as well as specialized programming, the school is receiving 0.5 additional psychologists. In SY2020-21, West received \$50,000 in one-time Chancellor's Initial Budget Assistance, which is not included in the school's initial SY2021-22 budget.

NEW: West will also receive additional stimulus funding in the approximate amount of \$191,044 to provide supplemental services to accelerate learning recovery and support students' social-emotional development. These funds are not included in the initial formula allocation total.
