Year-Over-Year Notes

MacFarland Middle School's FY23 submitted budget is \$10,291,434. This is an increase of \$36,619 over the initial FY23 allocation and an increase of \$178,421 over the FY22 submitted budget. The initial formula allocation includes \$25,423 in one-time recovery funds to provide stability during the pandemic. Additionally, during FY23 budget development, MacFarland MS received \$36,619 in Special Education (SPED) Hold Harmless Funds to account for DCPS's new SPED classroom realignment plan and its impact on the schools' buying power. School budgets are primarily driven by two factors: enrollment and unique student need. In SY21-22, MacFarland's projected enrollment was 641. In SY22-23, the school's projected enrollment is 587, a decrease of 54 students. MacFarland MS received \$2,683 per student eligible for at risk funding, bringing their total At Risk Supplement to \$641,118. MacFarland MS received \$37,132 in ESSER III acceleration funding, that is not included in their budget total. This year, security funds are not part of the FY23 school budget allocation and will be managed centrally. Security funding is excluded from both FY22 and FY23 budget totals; thus, this shift does not impact the school's year-over-year calculation or FY23 allocation.
