Year-Over-Year Notes

McKinley Middle School's FY23 submitted budget is \$5,042,969. This is an increase of \$ over the FY22 submitted budget. The initial formula allocation includes \$104,130 in Hold Harmless Funds to ensure that McKinley MS does not receive less than its submitted budget from last year. School budgets are primarily driven by two factors: enrollment and unique student need. In SY21-22, McKinley's projected enrollment was 300. In SY22-23, the school's projected enrollment is 281, a decrease of 19 students. McKinley MS received \$2,683 per student eligible for at risk funding, bringing their total At Risk Supplement to \$466,756. McKinley MS received \$68,007 in ESSER III acceleration funding, that is not included in their budget total. This year, security funds are not part of the FY23 school budget allocation and will be managed centrally. Security funding is excluded from both FY22 and FY23 budget totals; thus, this shift does not impact the school's year-over-year calculation or FY23 allocation.
