**Year-over-Year Notes:** This submitted budget worksheet reflects how School Without Walls High School's principal and school community aligned their FY24 allocation and tailored resources to meet the needs of their student population.

School Without Walls High School's FY24 submitted budget is \$6,536,432. This is the same level of funding as the school's initial FY24 allocation. School budgets are primarily driven by two factors: enrollment and unique student need. In SY22-23, School Without Walls's projected enrollment was 600. In SY23-24, the school's projected enrollment is 597, a decrease of 3 student(s). DCPS is continuing to pass through At-Risk UPSFF dollars to schools. School Without Walls HS is receiving \$2,818 per student eligible for UPSFF at-risk funding, bringing their UPSFF At-Risk Supplement to \$307,860.

School Without Walls is also receiving \$31,000 in FY24 ESSER III funding. This funding is not included in their budget total because these funds are one-time and supplemental to the school's annual DCPS formula funds. Security funds will continue to be managed centrally in FY24.
