Year-over-Year Notes: This submitted budget worksheet reflects how Dorothy Height Elementary School's principal and school community aligned and tailored their FY25 (SY24-25) allocation to meet the needs of their student population.

Dorothy Height Elementary School's FY25 submitted budget is \$9,270,864. This is an increase of \$267,444 compared to Dorothy Height's FY25 initial allocation. During budget development, Dorothy Height received \$267,444 in budget assistance for additional resources. Compared to their FY24 (SY23-24) approved budget, Dorothy Height's submitted budget total is an increase of \$628,479. The FY24 approved budget includes supplemental funds, including any funds awarded by DC Council. School budgets are primarily driven by projected enrollment, specific student needs, school programming, and position costs. In SY23-24, Dorothy Height's projected enrollment was 415. In SY24-25, the school's projected enrollment is 396, a decrease of 19 student(s). To support the social-emotional and academic needs of at-risk students, schools receive supplemental Uniform Per-Student Funding Formula (UPSFF) funds. Dorothy Height ES received an at-risk UPSFF supplement of \$803,953. Additional per-pupil at-risk dollars were provided to schools serving higher concentrations of students eligible for at-risk funding. Dorothy Height ES received \$46,204 in additional at-risk concentration funds because over 40% of their projected student enrollment is eligible for at-risk funding.

Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) funds were non-recurring, supplemental funds initially dispersed in the 2019-20 school year to support COVID-19 relief efforts and evidence-based acceleration programming. Last school year, school year 2023-24, was

the final year of the ESSER grant award. DCPS schools will not be allocated these funds moving forward.
