Year-over-Year Notes: This submitted budget worksheet reflects how Jefferson Middle School Academy's principal and school community aligned and tailored their FY25 (SY24-25) allocation to meet the needs of their student population.

Jefferson Middle School Academy's FY25 submitted budget is \$8,179,973. This is an increase of \$252,479 compared to Jefferson's FY25 initial allocation. During budget development, Jefferson received \$66,861 in budget assistance for additional resources. After principal budget submission, DCPS moved funding for Sixth Grade Academies from the Central Services budget to individual school budgets. Jefferson was allocated a Sixth Grade Academy Assistant Principal, which increased their submitted budget by \$185,618. Compared to their FY24 (SY23-24) approved budget, Jefferson's submitted budget total is an increase of \$1,691,802. The FY24 approved budget includes supplemental funds, including any funds awarded by DC Council. School budgets are primarily driven by projected enrollment, specific student needs, school programming, and position costs. In SY23-24, Jefferson's projected enrollment was 398. In SY24-25, the school's projected enrollment is 410, an increase of 12 student(s). To support the social-emotional and academic needs of at-risk students, schools receive supplemental Uniform Per-Student Funding Formula (UPSFF) funds. Jefferson Middle School Academy received an at-risk UPSFF supplement of \$910,883. Additional per-pupil at-risk dollars were provided to schools serving higher concentrations of students eligible for at-risk funding. Jefferson Middle School Academy received \$67,766 in additional at-risk concentration funds because over 40% of their projected student enrollment is eligible for at-risk funding.

Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) funds were non-recurring, supplemental funds initially dispersed in the 2019-20 school year to support COVID-19 relief efforts and evidence-based acceleration programming. Last school year, school year 2023-24, was the final year of the ESSER grant award. DCPS schools will not be allocated these funds moving forward.
