Year-over-Year Notes: This submitted budget worksheet reflects how Walker-Jones Education Campus's principal and school community aligned and tailored their FY25 (SY24-25) allocation to meet the needs of their student population.

Walker-Jones Education Campus's FY25 submitted budget is \$7,679,635. There were no changes to their FY25 initial allocation total. Compared to their FY24 (SY23-24) approved budget, Walker-Jones's submitted budget total is an increase of \$81,418. The FY24 approved budget includes supplemental funds, including any funds awarded by DC Council. School budgets are primarily driven by projected enrollment, specific student needs, school programming, and position costs. In SY23-24, Walker-Jones's projected enrollment was 337. In SY24-25, the school's projected enrollment is 285, a decrease of 52 student(s). To support the social-emotional and academic needs of at-risk students, schools receive supplemental Uniform Per-Student Funding Formula (UPSFF) funds. Walker-Jones EC received an at-risk UPSFF supplement of \$922,764. Additional per-pupil at-risk dollars were provided to schools serving higher concentrations of students eligible for at-risk funding. Walker-Jones EC received \$156,068 in additional at-risk concentration funds because over 70% of their projected student enrollment is eligible for at-risk funding.

Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) funds were non-recurring, supplemental funds initially dispersed in the 2019-20 school year to support COVID-19 relief efforts and evidence-based acceleration programming. Last school year, school year 2023-24, was the final year of the ESSER grant award. DCPS schools will not be allocated these funds moving forward.
